## Arrangements relating to vendors' temporary suspension of the sales of first-hand residential properties on the Lunar New Year Eve and during the Lunar New Year public holidays (24 to 28 January 2020)

On the Lunar New Year Eve and/or during the Lunar New Year public holidays (**from 24 to 28 January 2020**), vendors may temporarily suspend the offer to sell first-hand residential properties in their developments/phases, including closing the sales offices and the premises where they have been making available hard copies of the sales brochures, price list(s), document(s) containing the sales arrangements and the Register of Transactions for the developments/phases for collection/inspection by the public.

Having taken into account practical circumstances, the Sales of First-hand Residential Properties Authority (SRPA) hereby informs vendors that, with regard to first-hand residential properties which have been offered for sale before 24 January 2020 (i.e. the first date of sale of any of the first-hand residential properties in the development/phase has taken place on or after 29 April 2013 and before 24 January 2020), if vendors temporarily suspend the offer to sell those properties any time during the period from 24 to 28 January 2020 and then resume to offer to sell those properties on or before 29 January 2020, the SRPA does not require the vendors to make available a document setting out categorically the sales arrangements relating to the suspension and the resumption of the offer to sell provided that the sales arrangements of those properties after the resumption of the offer to sell will be the same as the sales arrangements of those properties which were effective before the temporary suspension of the offer to sell of those properties. Vendors may resume offering to sell those properties with immediate effect after their holiday break.
